CHIEF EXECUTIVE'S REPORT (cont.).

CNS: Community National Schools (CNS) are state-operated, multidenominational, inclusive schools that welcome all children from the local communities they serve. The State has now developed its own primary school model with the Community National Schools. The patron of CNS schools is the Education and Training Boards (ETBs). To date, there are 11 Community National Schools in Dublin, Wicklow, Meath, Kildare and Cork. Each CNS has thrived in the areas they are in and have developed reputations for their inclusive ethos and commitment to excellence in education. It was agreed that the CE would engage with our 5 Bishops – Bishop of Elphin, Killala, Tuam, Achonry and Kilmore with a view to increasing the number of multidenominational schools.
